Surge Fitness-by Corrie Rogness

Hazen Fitness is now under new ownership and doing business as Surge Fitness. Tim and I, Corrie, purchased the business in October of 2015. One of the great perks of being a member at Surge Fitness is 24/7 access. Each member receives a key and can access the fitness center anytime of day or night. We offer a variety of equipment. We have standard bikes, recombinent bikes, Elipticals, and treadmills for those needing cardio conditioning. For those that are into lifting we have a squat/benchpress cage and free weights. We also have easy to use weight lifting equipment designed to work your shoulders, gluts, calves, abdomen, back, quadriceps, and hamstrings. For members that require a little extra push and work better in a group we offer a variety of classes. Classes that we have available currently include: spin, strength and conditioning, Boot camp, group outdoor running (weather permitting), and yoga. In the past we have offered step and HIIT classes. Classes may change from month to month so we always encourage members and individuals wanting to attend a class to check facebook for any announcement pertaining to classes offered, times, and cancelations.

Surge Fitness has a variety of membership options. An individual can purchase a membership just to attend fitness classes. We however, recommend purchasing a full gym membership so a member has access to all of the equipment and classes. We offer single, couple, and family packages. Memberships can be purchased for different lengths of time. Members can join for a single month, six months, or a year. The longer the membership contract the better the rate. For simplicity we can set up automatic withdrawal from a members checking out and we now have the option of accepting credit cards as a form of payment. We do allow people to drop in and work out for the day for a minimal fee but that is restricted to the staffed daytime hours. Surge Fitness is staffed from four to seven Monday through Thursday. Individuals are encouraged to come to Surge Fitness during these times to sign up. We do realize that many individuals work and cannot come in during these times so my, Corrie's, cell phone is listed on facebook as well as the business door so an individual can schedule a time to sign up outside of standard business hours. Surge Fitness is designated as Silver Sneakers and Silver and Fit site. Surge Fitness members that have fitness coverage through their insurance carrier are encouraged to visit with staff so we can fill out the proper paperwork to get members reimbursed. Sanford, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of ND, and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of MN are a few of the plans that have fitness incentives. Members can get \$20 back per month if they attend the gym 12 time per month, so make sure to check into insurance coverage.

At Surge we make exercising easy, due to 24/7 access, and fun, due to a variety of exercise options for all fitness levels. We have great instructors: Azia, Marya, and Sarah. Our instructors are enthusiastic and encouraging. Classes are taught to meet everyone's fitness level. You may see our children Jase and Sydney putting in some hours as well. We pride ourselves on providing a clean, up-to-date, and friendly fitness facility open to members at all fitness levels. Please come in and check out Surge Fitness. We would love to show you around, sign you up, and get you started on a healthier, happier you.

Tues. & Thur.8 a.m. - 6 p.m.

• **Not Open On Saturdays**

• *Loads are required to be covered when hauling to landfill. Loads should also be sorted for your own convenience.*

• *For Hazen residents only. ID may be required.*

Garbage routes will run as usual.

Have clean-up items and regular trash out by 6 a.m. the **day before** your regular day.

- **NO Call Necessary to City Hall**
- *Have items sorted at curb.*
- *Household, wood, steel and inert items need to be sorted at your regular garbage pickup areas. If not sorted, it will not get picked up.*

TREE AND GRASS DISPOSAL

Site located north of Cenex
Discarding any other items at this site is a **VIOLATION** of City Ordinance and subject to a \$1,000 fine.

VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED

EXAMPLES OF FREE PICKUP:

- Normal household items
- Wood products ~ sorted and separated from regular garbage
- Discarded furniture • Carpet

Residents are encouraged to clean up their nuisance/junk vehicles. The city will be willing to assist with this process during clean-up week. After clean-up, the city will be enforcing ordinances and issuing citations.

Auto & pickup\$2.00 ea.
Truck.....\$5.00 ea.

NOT ACCEPTED AT LANDFILL

- Car batteries • Motor oil • Liquid paint
- Flammables such as paint thinner
- Tree branches • Grass clippings, etc.
