Landlords and RV Park Operators are encouraged to provide information about their vacancies to the Hazen Chamber of Commerce & CVB. According to Brianna Hochhalter, Executive Director, they are preparing for the influx of workers expected this spring to the Beulah and Hazen area.

Nearly 400 workers are expected to begin work on the Urea Plant west of Beulah beginning as soon as March. Housing these workers for the next two years of construction will be a challenge for the area and presents opportunity to local landlords.

This listing of available housing for workers coming to the region is being maintained by the Hazen Chamber through collaboration with the Beulah Chamber of Commerce, Hazen Community Development, Dunn County Jobs Development Authority and the Rural Economic Area Partnership Investment Fund.

The landlord form for listing current vacancies can be picked up at the organizations listed earlier and is also found on their websites. Landlords are encouraged to complete and return the form as soon as possible as workers will be here before we know it!
