


PUBLIC NOTICE

EFFECTIVE

NOVEMBER 1, 2014



**As of the above date the city sanitation department
WILL NO LONGER PICK UP ANY TRASH RECEPTACLES
THAT CONTAIN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:**

Tree Branches • Leaves • Grass Clippings • Lead Acid Batteries
Infectious Wastes • Used Motor Oil • Containers of Paint

The Mercer County Regional Landfill does not accept these items at this time.

**Also, the sanitation department will
not pick up residential containers that contain:**

Scrap Wood/Metal • Carpet • Concrete/Rocks
Construction Debris • Industrial Waste

Any owner/occupant found placing these items in the trash receptacle is punishable by a penalty not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each offense. This does not apply for a special event such as "clean-up week" when approved, sorted items will be picked up for disposal.

All garbage placed in trash receptacles is to be bagged and receptacles are to be placed at the end of the driveway; in the curb gutter; or at the end of the street/access road to be picked up. Any owner/occupant that fails to comply with these requirements will not receive any collection until the following week on the normal collection day.
